

Remove Low Voltage Warning from a Device



Before You Begin

Plug a wired USB keyboard and wired USB mouse into any open USB port on the back of the K-Tech Connect device.

Hide Low Voltage Warning

Close the K-Tech Connect Application

If the K-Tech Connect app is open on the device, press Alt + F4 or Ctrl + W to close the app.

Open a Terminal

Using the keyboard, press Ctrl + Alt + T to open a terminal.

Open Configuration File

Type **sudo nano /boot/config.txt** in the terminal, then press **Enter**.

Edit Configuration File

Using the arrow keys, scroll down to the end of the file and add the following text on a new line.

avoid_warnings=1

Save Configuration File & Exit

Using the keyboard, press Ctrl + O, then press Enter to save, then press Ctrl + X to exit.

Remove Low Voltage Warning Plug-in

Run Removal Command

Go back to the terminal and type **sudo apt remove lxplug-ptbatt -y** in the terminal, then press **Enter**.

Reboot Device

Reboot the Device

Go back to the terminal and type **shutdown now -r** then press **Enter**. The device will reboot and the low voltage warning will no longer be displayed.
